

2012 MYCCA Guideline for Hosting a Cheerleading Competition

- Check the Date and the time of your competition – Make sure the date and the time are correct.
- Officials assigned by Susan Hartnett (SEHartnett@comcast.net 207-837-7073)

Fees for Competition:

- Lead Official: \$ 96.00 stipend (Susan will be lead official unless she is not available).
- Official: \$65.00 stipend (you will be assigned 3 panel officials, 1 lead official and 1 safety official).
- There is an assigning fee of \$9 per official including the lead official. This should be paid to Susan.

- You will not be allowed to provide your own safety check official – Susan will assign this for you.

- 1-12 routines = 1 stipend. 13-24 routines = 2 stipends. 25-36 or more = 3 stipends and so on. **Stipends are determined / paid per session.**
- Mileage is \$.44 per mile, up to 125 miles, and \$.22 for the remaining mileage. Officials will car pool as much as possible; arrangements will be made prior to the competition.

Competition Responsibilities:

- You will need two tabulators, two calculators, and a stapler.
- Pencils, 2 red pens, stapler, and extra staples.
- 42 X 42 mat – The strips should be placed front to back with the strips going vertical. Make a cross to mark the center vertically and horizontally.
- Officials' tables set outside of basketball boundaries or set far enough back from the performing mat. You need as many seats for officials and tabulators assigned.
- A designated coaches' box or coaches' sitting area.
- An announcer / DJ or a person assigned to play the music.
- P.A. system. An alternative system if the system goes down.
- A trainer (certified EMT not an RN).
- A room for coaches to meet.
- A room for officials to meet.
- Two stop watches
- Copies of score sheets. Rising Star = 1 copy for each official. All other teams = enough copies for all teams (plus a few extras) of official 1, 2, and 3.

The Lead Official will contact you the Monday prior to the competition. Please give the Lead Official your cell phone where you may be reached prior to the competition in case of severe weather conditions or for an emergency.

Day of the Competition:

- Assign a person to register teams.
- Have the teams sign up for a five - six minute warm-up time on the performing mat. (Someone will need to time this warm-up.)
- Allow for a ten to fifteen minute open tumbling warm-up time. The person timing the warm-up should direct the tumblers when to proceed with the tumbling.
- Have extra strips of mat so the teams can use it to stretch out prior to performing.
- Concession Stand.
- The coaches' Meeting should be scheduled thirty minutes prior to the start of the competition.
- National Anthem for the start of the competition.
